The former Pope & Talbot Wood Treating Site, located at 1550 Railroad Avenue in St. Helens, operated from 1912 to 1960. The Port of Columbia County purchased the property in 1963 and has been working with the Oregon DEQ for several years to assess contamination and develop a cleanup plan.

In 2023, the Oregon DEQ approved a Record of Decision outlining the cleanup plan for both upland and in-water creosote contamination. The Port is applying for grants to help fund cleanup of the first priority action area.
